The Lead Promotor Comunitario will serve as the liaison between the Program Manager and Promotor Comunitarios in each region to promote vaccine equity in the San Bernardino Region. The project will provide outreach, education and support to reduce COVID-19 vaccine hesitancy among the Latino communities within that area.

Candidates must have a high school diploma or GED equivalence. A preferred candidate will have a minimum of two (2) years' experience working with monolingual and/or bilingual communities. A minimum of two (2) years of experience working with projects related to health care access and health care coverage in underserved communities. Competency with technology is also required for basic work functions. A bilingual candidate (English and Spanish) is highly desirable. Flexible work hours including evenings, weekends, and some holidays will be required.
